EU Directive (2002/95/EC), better known as The Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS), affects manufacturers, sellers and distributors of electrical and electronic equipment and components. Its goal is to protect the environment and human health through the restriction of certain hazardous substances in new equipment.

In particular, this directive states: **From July 1, 2006, producers of new electrical and electronic equipment must demonstrate that their products do not contain more than the maximum permitted levels of:**

- Lead, including lead/tin solder
- Mercury
- Cadmium
- Hexavalent chromium
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBBs) and
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDEs)
- Pentabromodiphenyl ether (PentaBDE) flame retardant
- Octabromodiphenyl ether (OctaBDE) flame retardant
- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE) flame retardant

All of the base materials offered by Carey Manufacturing comply with the requirements of RoHS.

The following finishes do not meet the requirements of RoHS, but will continue to be offered for domestic applications;

- -10 (Cadmium, Yellow Chromate Conversion)
- -11 (Cadmium, Clear Chromate Conversion)
- -19 (Zinc, Yellow Chromate Conversion)
